## English 12 Honors Vocabulary Schedule

In this course, we will uncover units 1-6 in the Sadlier-Oxford Level G text. **We will spend two weeks on each unit** and will follow a pattern for preparing for the quizzes:

### WEEK ONE:

- A typed, one page, double-spaced **creative writing piece** will always be due on Friday. See the following schedule for more details. You will be provided with a picture prompt for each unit. **You must use a minimum of ten vocabulary words per story.**

### WEEK TWO:

- A 25-question, **multiple-choice quiz** will always be given on Friday. You will need a #2 pencil. Types of questions will include definitions, synonyms and antonyms, and sentence completion.

### Cumulative Assessments

After every third unit, there will be a cumulative test which will be written. Also, a portion of the final exam will cover all six units. These test dates are indicated on the calendar below.

### Creative Writing Pieces

Your pieces will be graded on a scale of 0-20 based on the following categories:

- Accurate, smooth, and relevant use of vocabulary; correct spelling of each vocab word! *10 points*
- Logical, classroom-appropriate construction of the piece that is relevant to picture prompt. *5 points*
- Overall mechanics (spelling and grammar) and formatting (typed, one page, double-spaced). *5 points*
